

Mountain Havoc General, Technical, Safety Requirements

- Vehicles shall be in good running/operating condition.
- All components of competing vehicles must be in good working order. i.e., no cracks, bent, broken or leaking components.
- All fluids must be vented to a containment can or overflow bottle away from heat sources.
- Automatic transmissions must have a locking dipstick.
- Vehicle must be able to roll over without spilling fluids. Use roll over valve or 3 loop method.
- Driver & Co Driver must be shielded from all fluids.
- Batteries and fuel cells must be permanently mounted. Permanent means no bungees or ratchet straps.
- Any battery mounted in the passenger compartment must be vented to the outside of the vehicle.
- Kill switch is mandatory and must effectively shut off the vehicles and accessories.
- Must have a minimum of two (2) 2.5 lb. fire extinguishers in reach of both driver and co-driver.
- Driver and Co-Driver must have SFI rated outer wear.
- DOT or Snell approved helmets.
- Recovery strap, adequate tree strap, shackle required.
- Minimum tire size of 44". If sidewall is labeled with size, it will pass. If it is not labeled, it will have to be measured.
- Steel winch lines require a winch weight. Please have in your vehicle at time of tech
- Adequate tree straps must be used when winching off any tree.
- Brakes must be in good working order at all times.
- All pinion brakes must have some type of guard to protect from ground.
- All tech decisions are subject to Judge's discretion.
- Tech Judge has the authority to approve or deny race eligibility as they see fit.

CAGE RULES

- All cages must have a minimum 6 points of contact with the frame.
- All cages must consist of sufficient tubing. DOM recommended.
- All cages must have an X or sufficient triangulation behind occupants.
- All cages must have sufficient head room from roof. 5 inch minimum
- All A pillars and B pillars must connect directly to the main frame.
- When sitting in your vehicle, arms must not reach past the windshield.
- All tubes must be welded 360 degrees and or gusseted with sufficient reinforcement.
- Any splices in the roll cage must have sufficient internal slugs.
- A metal plate must be fastened over the occupants' heads. Steel or aluminum.
- Door bars must be shoulder height next to occupants.
- Passenger grab bar required.
- All vehicles must have complete firewall and floorboards shielding occupants from all moving parts, fluids & exhaust.
- Must have properly installed 5-point restraint and harness in good working order. Harness must be mounted properly with correct angles and geometry. (Do your research). If Tech Judge deems your seat belt mounts are not safe, you will not race.

General Rules for Mountain Havoc Event

- No consuming alcoholic drinks for Driver or Co Driver during active competition, you will be disqualified. Once you are done competing for the day you are allowed.
- Numbers will be drawn randomly. Running order will be divided by the number of events and drivers.
- Follow running order and be lined up and ready to race when it is your turn. If you have a mechanical issue and need to be bumped to the back, please let the course starter know immediately.
- Speed. 5MPH max on main roads. If you break this rule, you will be disqualified. This is a spectator event, so they are everywhere.
- Team Pit Rigs. One pit rig per race team. You will need to obtain a pit rig sticker in order to operate on the ranch. Please keep pit rigs out of the fairgrounds.
- Test & tune in designated areas at designated times only. Please confirm with Ben.
- You are responsible for your safety equipment to be ready to race, come to the start line ready to go. The race starter will do a general check with you.
- Wear your seatbelts at all times, seatbelts must be tight.
- Recovery will happen between the driver and the excavator operator. You will need to hook up your vehicle, we will not extract until you give the go ahead. Recovery staff will be there to help.
- If any safety factor of a vehicle is compromised, it will need to be repaired before continuing. If there is major damage, you will be stopped.
- The Judge can stop a driver at any time during competition. You must adhere to the Judges directions.
- No one is permitted on course other than the Driver, Co-Driver, Judges and recovery staff. All other competitors and spectators must stay off course.
- Vehicle cannot move until all occupants are securely buckled in.
- Winches must be spooled in or secured appropriately.
- Tree straps required, winch weights for steel winch lines. You will be penalized/disqualified if you do not have a winch weight.

- No touching the winch cable when vehicle is moving. This will result in disqualification.
- Co-Driver does not need to cross the finish line, vehicle only.
- Disrespect to staff, other driver or spectators will not be tolerated. We reserve the right to refuse entrance, service or race eligibility to anyone at our discretion.

Scoring

- Scoring starts at 100 Point for first place in said event then decreases by 3 points to the next place. 1ST 100 points, 2ND 97 points and so on. You will receive 5 bonus points for finishing the course.
- Mountain Man Course points start at 200 for 1st place and then decreases by 6 to the next place, so 2nd place would be 194 and so on. You will get 10 bonus points for finishing this course.
- Tie Breakers will be determined by drivers placement in the Mountain Man Course.
- Total points from all 5 events will determine over all placements.

General Park Rules

All rules must be followed. Zero tolerance & no exceptions

- All State, Federal and Local laws apply on the Purcell Trench Ranch private property.
- Enter and participate at your own risk.
- Wear event wristband at all times.
- Anyone under the age of 18, must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or legal guardian.
- Stay inside the Purcell Trench Ranch Boundaries marked with green and white flagging.
- Speed limit is 5mph, except in designated areas.
- Obey all staff and signage.
- Drivers and passengers must wear seatbelts and safety restraints at all in times in vehicle.
- Fighting or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.
- 11 p.m. is shut down time, No driving, wheeling, music or loud noises.
- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- NO PETS. NO EXCEPTIONS. Unless otherwise specified.
- No Glass, fireworks, dirt bikes, 3 or 4 wheelers, weapons, chainsaws.
- Please help us keep our park clean by not littering, we have trashcans throughout the park and huge dumpster at the exit.
- We reserve the right to refuse service or entrance to anyone.
- Gate Hours (unless otherwise posted) Friday 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Sunday 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Gate close at 11:00 p.m. for entrance, you may leave at any time but cannot come back into the event until 7:00 a.m.

- Campfires will be allowed in low fire danger season. They must be in an above ground fire pit with a bottom. No on ground fires. We will post on the page whether fires will be allowed or not.

Please note anyone endangering themselves, the safety of others, or not complying with the above listed requirements will be escorted off the property. Anyone asked to leave and is unable to drive themselves or doesn't not have a responsible ride will be removed by the Sherriff.
